-Entries must have been made between June 1, 2022 and the cookout date. Entries must be brought to the cookout for judging.

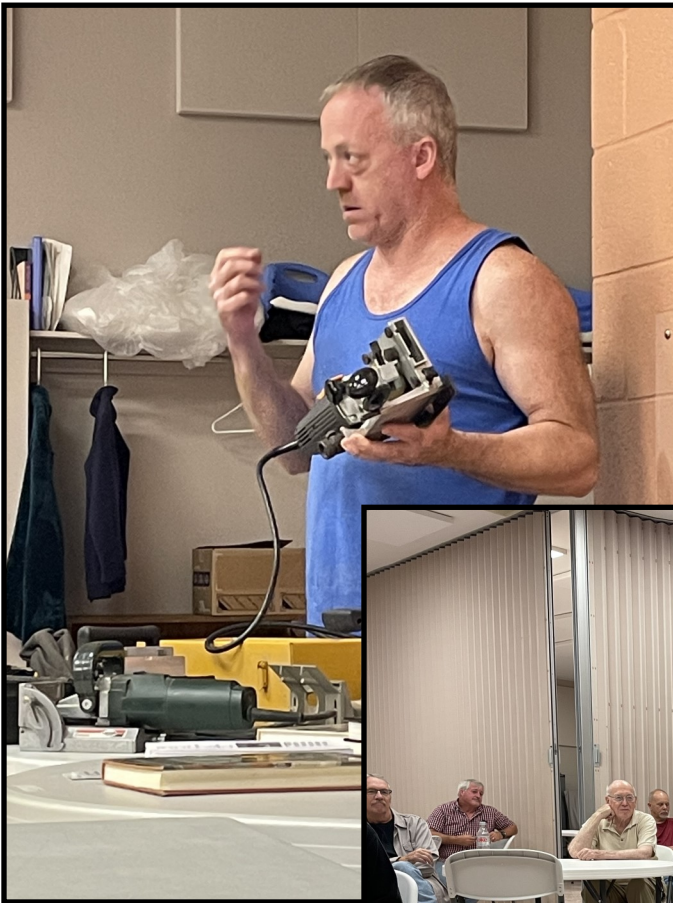
-Winners will be announced at the end of the cookout.

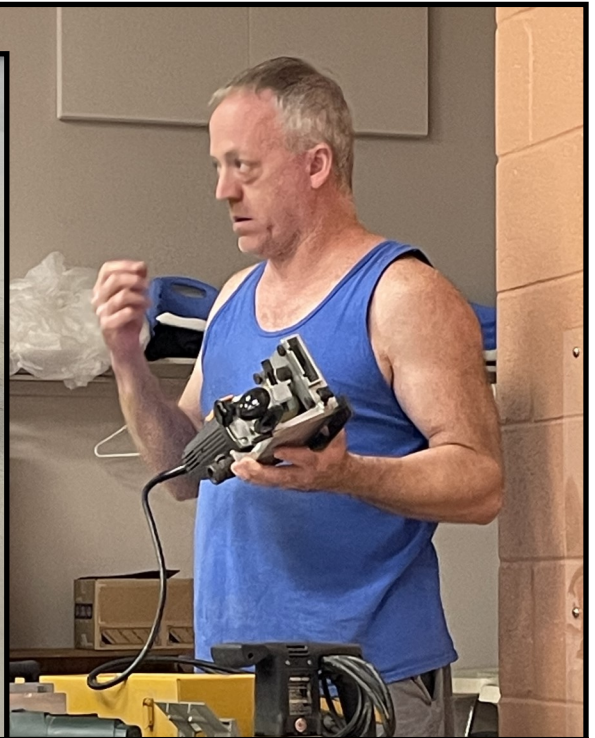
We have several months to come up with something. I hope to see a lot of entries,
