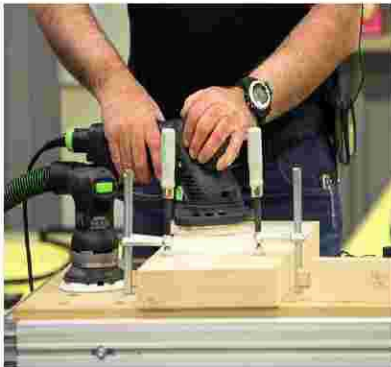
THIS MONTH'S MEETING

Table Saw Safety Tip Setting Your Blade's Height

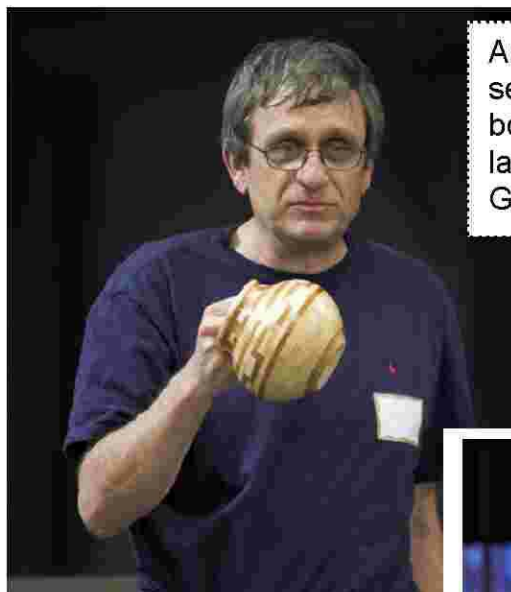
One slip while working with a table saw can cost you a couple of fingers, or worse. Setting your table saw's blade to no more than **one tooth's height** above the workpiece can minimize the damage if your hand should slip.

Need another reason? Your table saw will not need to work as hard because you are minimizing the friction on the blade.

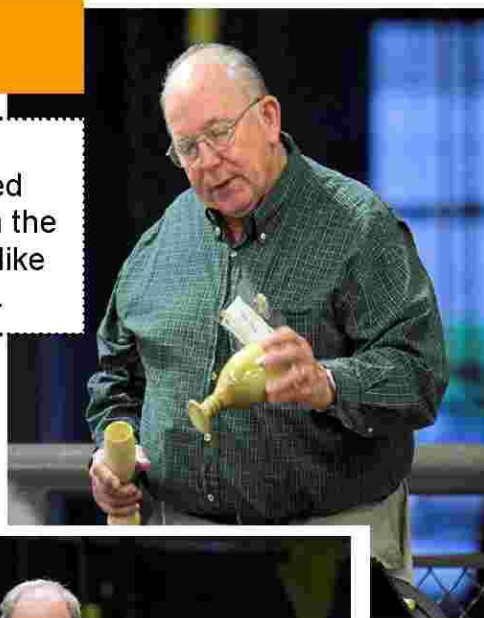
Note the guard was removed from the saw for the picture.
