This is your group. It is what you help make it!

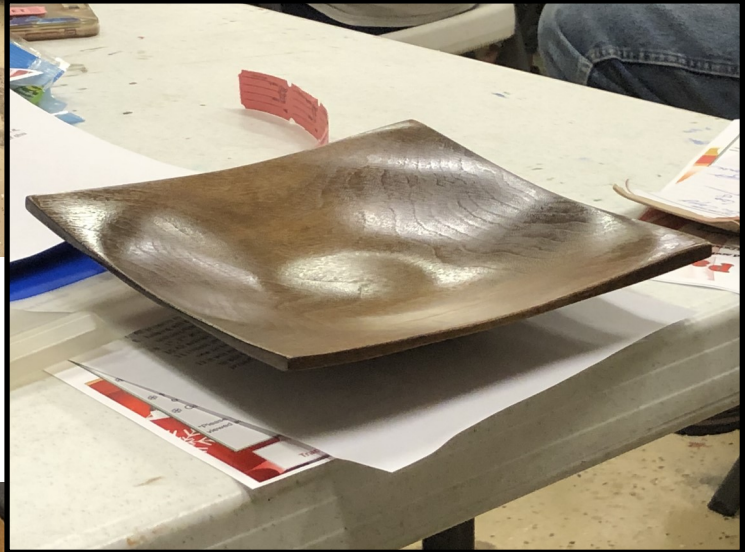

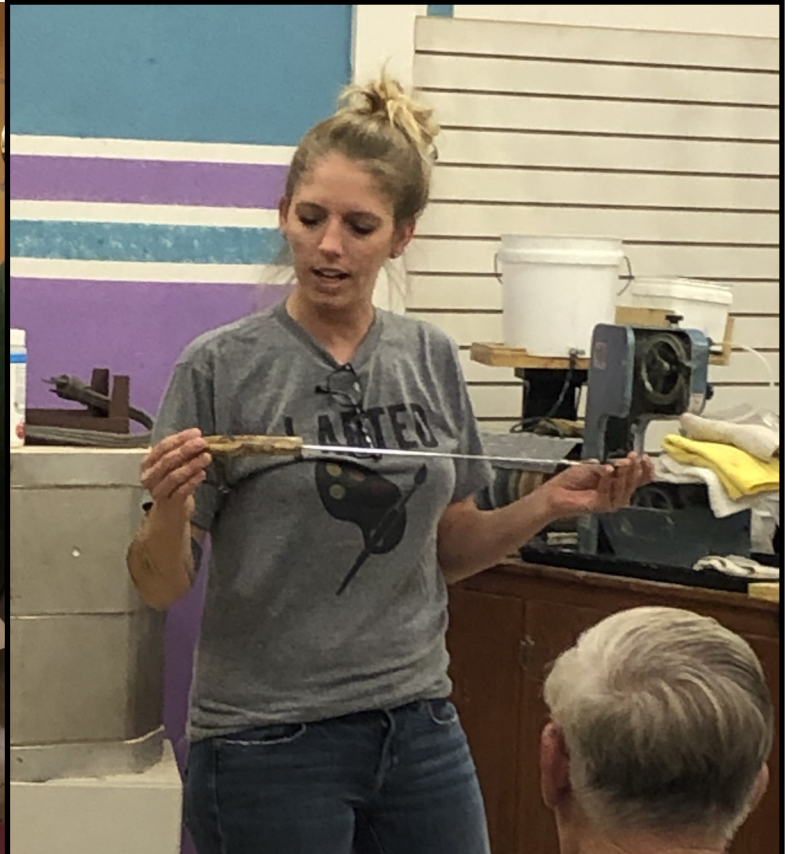

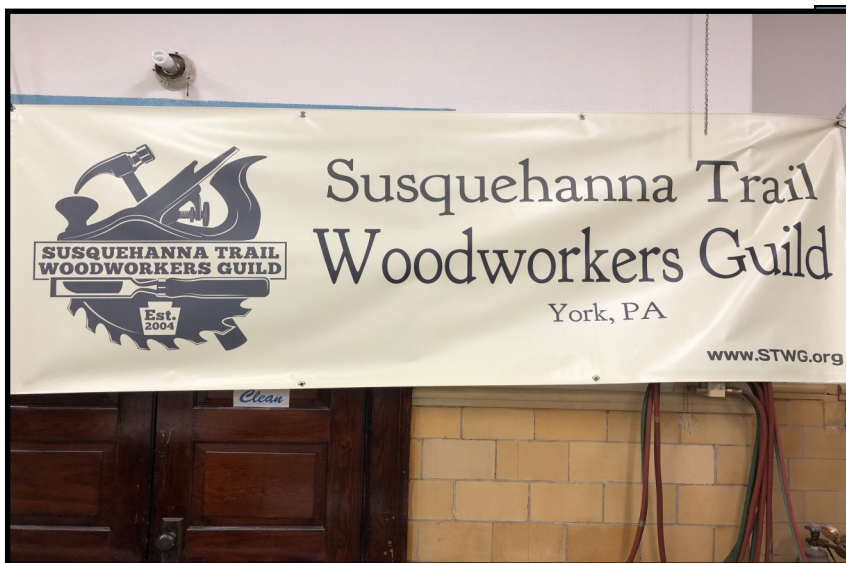

THE PRESIDENTS CHALLENGE**The Challenge—Make a 16x16 panel from 1/4 inch plywood.**

1. Design a pattern based on a quilt pattern, or a pattern of your own choice.
2. Must use at least three different colors of wood.
3. Must use a 90°, 45°, and at least four 22 1/2° angles in your design.
4. Can use the intarsia method by sanding all edges into smooth curves to obtain a more 3-D effect, or use the jigsaw effect where the entire surface is smooth.
5. A finish of poly or shellac must be used.
6. All projects must use 1/4" wood to keep the weight down.
7. All projects must have a border around the outer edges.
8. Judging will be held at the Christmas party, using three non-members as judges.
9. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will receive ribbon/medal.
10. All entries will be on display at the woodworking show in January.
11. Unless other plans are made, all panels will be mounted together to make one or two large "quilts" and donated to a hospital or nursing home.
12. It will be up to the President to make one or two panels with the Guilds logo on it, to add to the quilt to identify our group as the designer and fabricator of this project. This will also function as advertisement for our group.
13. Each person can enter up to 3 panels
14. There will be an entry fee to help raise funds for the Guild: First entry: \$5. Second entry: \$3. Third entry: \$1
