PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

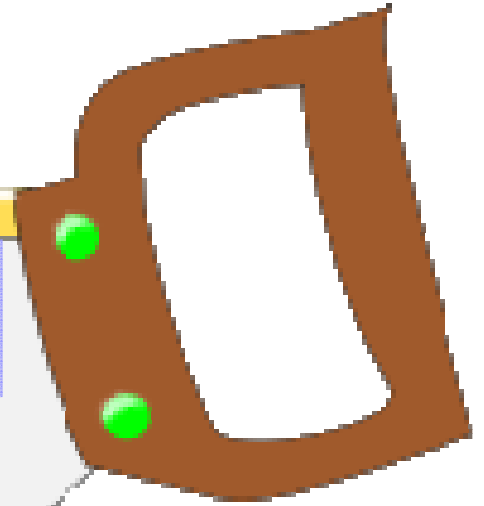

UpCycling 101



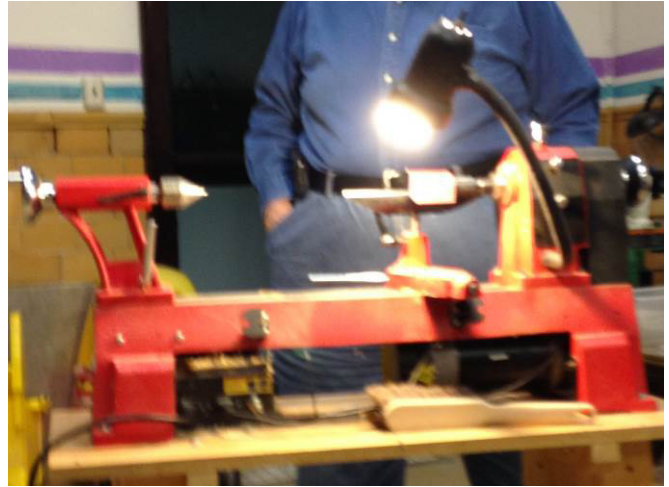
UPCYCLE—to reuse (discarded objects or material) in such a way as to create a product of a higher quality or value than the original.

Do you have an old treadle sewing machine stand or a stack of old crates lying around? Come and listen as this month's speaker discusses how he takes old and discarded items and repurposes them-- giving them new life. Jack Kapp will be our guest speaker once again. Jack professes to having more than half a century of experience and will answer any questions that you may have.

Last month our meeting was dedicated to the topic of Small Project Woodturning. During the meeting, we saw a live demonstration as Jack took a small square of wood and turned it into a finished product. As the chips flew, we saw a wine bottle stopper quickly take form. After the gentle curves and decorative cuts—Jack made it all look easy as he stepped thru the multiple grade of sandpaper and the application of the sealing CA glue finish.
