In June of 2021 we moved our meeting location to Faith United Church, at 509 Pacific Avenue. January 2026 marked our return to the York Town Craft Guild.

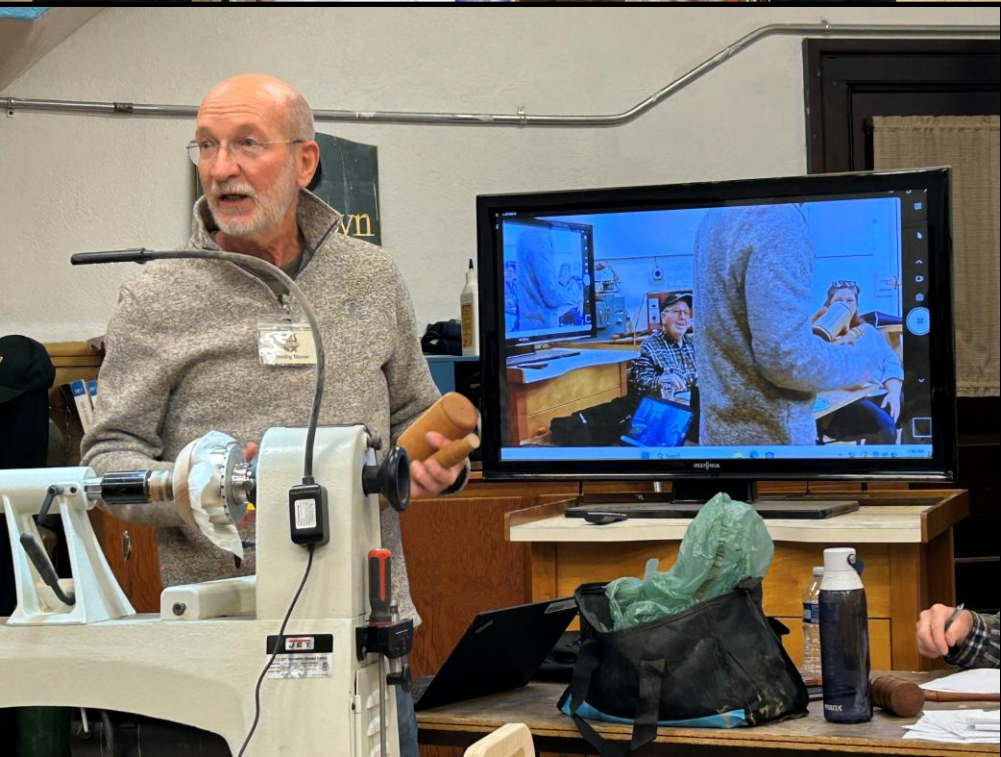

## Pictures from the Feb. meeting

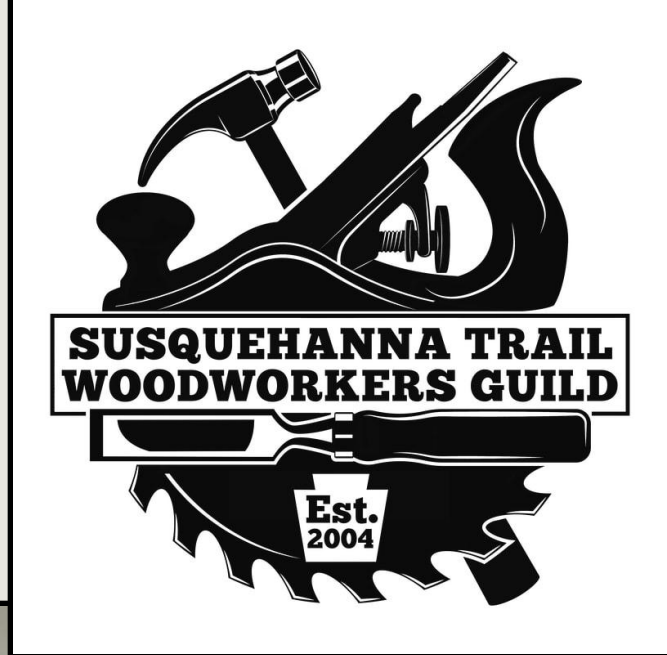


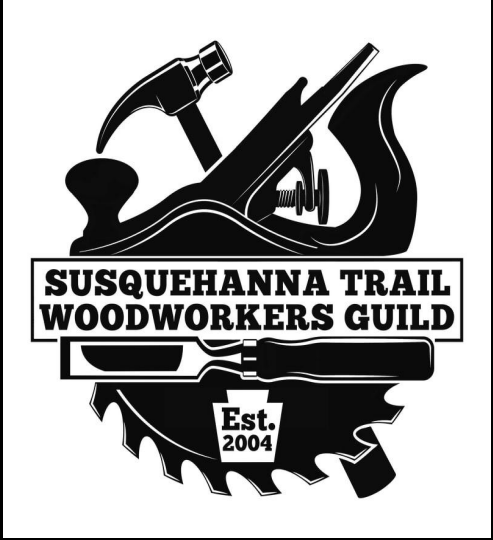
