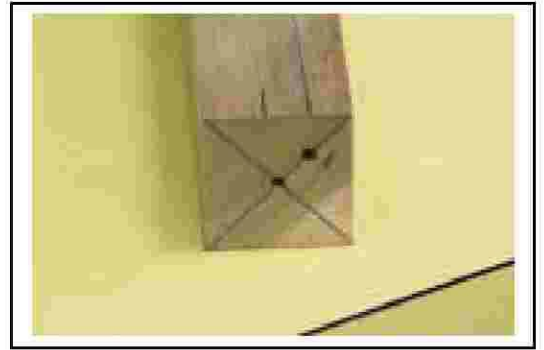
## BIG RAFFEL AT THIS MONTH'S MEETING

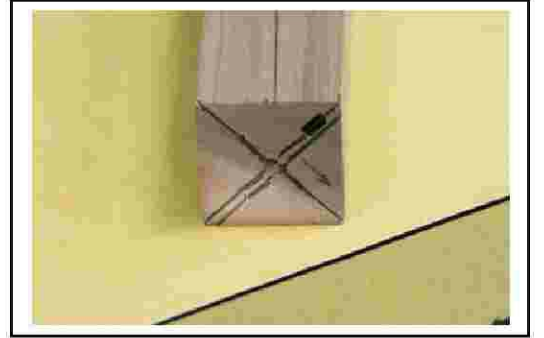
