See you Thursday at 6:00 p.m.



AUGUST SHOW & TELL




Jack Kapp never turns off the lights in his shop. The candy dish was turned from segmented cut walnut, the vase and wine bottle stopper were made from plywood.

Palmer Burke is busy working on his 1 1/2 items per day to meet the Christmas deadline. The trinket box was made with ambrosia maple and a lacquer finish.




